3. Poems or Haikus should be written or typed on one side of A4 paper. The writer's name must not appear on the A4 sheet. This is because poems will be judged anonymously.

4. Each entry must be sent with a completed Blossom Day Entry Form.

5. All entries must be in English and the entrant's own original work. Entries must not previously have been published, broadcast or have won another competition.

6. Entrants must be under the age of 12 (Primary School category) or under the age of 19 (Secondary School category) on the closing date, Friday 2nd April 2021.

7. All entries must be <u>received</u> by email by Friday 2nd April 2021 or earlier.

8. The judges' decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into concerning this decision.
